1	OWNER/APPLICANT NAME	The name of the person who currently owns the candidate sheep. Only current owners who are BBSAI members in "good standing" may apply to register sheep under the AB Open Registration process.					
2	FLOCK PREFIX	The three (3) characters of the owner's BBSAI flock identification (e.g., DJF).					
3	BBSAI FLOCK NAME	The name of the owner's flock as recorded by the BBSAI (e.g., Double J).					
4	CANDIDATE SHEEP NAME	The common or "pet" name of the candidate sheep. This name will be appended to the flock name and become the sheep's official registered name (e.g., Double J Helen).

6	PERMANENT IDENTIFICATION	The candidate sheep's permanently affixed identification.
