Instructions for completing the AB Open Registration Application Form

①	OWNER/APPLICANT NAME	The name of the person who currently owns the candidate sheep. Only current owners who are BBSAI members in “good standing” may apply to register sheep under the AB Open Registration process.
②	FLOCK PREFIX	The three (3) characters of the owner’s BBSAI flock identification (e.g., DJF).
③	BBSAI FLOCK NAME	The name of the owner’s flock as recorded by the BBSAI (e.g., Double J).
④	CANDIDATE SHEEP NAME	The common or “pet” name of the candidate sheep. This name will be appended to the flock name and become the sheep’s official registered name (e.g., Double J Helen).
⑤	SEX	R = ram E = ewe
⑥	PERMANENT IDENTIFICATION	The candidate sheep’s permanently affixed identification. This may be an ear tag, RFID, microchip or tattoo with the individual animal identification number or code mandated/assigned by government authority for animal traceability (e.g., USDA Scrapie ID – AL192-0110; CCIA ID –1240005001390707).
⑦	DATE OF BIRTH	mm/dd/yyyy (e.g., 05/22/2022 = May 5, 2022)
⑧	TYPE OF BIRTH	S=single TW=twin TP=triplet QD=quadruplet
⑨	SIRE/DAM INFORMATION	Provide the name, permanent ID and registration number of the candidate sheep’s sire and dam, if known.
⑩	BREEDER’S NAME, ADDRESS AND FLOCK ID	Provide the name of the breeder of the candidate sheep, if different than the Owner/Applicant, and their address and flock identification number/code. The owner of the candidate sheep’s dam at the time of service is the Breeder.
⑪	RELATIONSHIPS	Provide any known information regarding the candidate sheep’s relationship to other flocks or bloodline with as much identifying information as possible about those flocks/bloodlines.
⑫	ESTIMATION OF COI	If possible, provide the coefficient of inbreeding (COI) for the candidate sheep. The COI is an estimate of the probability that the sheep has common ancestors, expressed in percentage, e.g., the relatedness of its parents.
