



Certificate of Parentage/Service

Use this form when you are registering sheep whose sire and/or dam were not owned by you at the time of breeding. This form **MUST** be signed by the owner of the sire and/or dam and attached to the registration form for the sheep you are registering.

NOTE: If you purchased bred registered ewes and have submitted their registration certificates to the BBSAI for transfer of ownership to your name, and if the seller/breeder completed the breeding information section on the back of that registration certificate, then you do not need to use this form.

The person who owned the dam of the sheep to be registered at the time of breeding must complete this:

Here are some scenarios to help you figure out what you need to do in certain registration situations:

If I want to register lambs born to...	Then...
1. Ewes that I own and were bred on my farm to a ram that I own.	You must complete the regular Registration Application form.
2. Ewes bred elsewhere, which I then purchased and whose lambs were then born on my farm.	<p>Seller of ewes signs the statement of breeding section on back of registration certificate.</p> <p>You must send in the registration form to BBSAI to process the transfer.</p> <p>Note: If Seller has not completed breeding section on back of registration certificate, then Seller must submit Certificate of Parentage/Certificate of Service to you, and you will attach it to a Registration Application form.</p>
3. Ewes bred elsewhere whose lambs were born elsewhere and had not been registered when I purchased them.	Seller of lambs must submit Certificate of Parentage/Certificate of Service to you, and you will attach it to a Registration Application form.
4. Ewes that I own that were bred to a borrowed or leased ram.	Owner of ram submits Certificate of Service form to you, and you will attach it to a Registration Application form.

Note: All transfers of ownership must be completed prior to registering lambs born to (or sired by) those animals.
